

2 SUFFIXES

Most suffixes **change a word to a different part of speech**. When we add a suffix, we sometimes change the spelling of the original word (*silent* > *silence*; *glamour* > *glamorous*). The stress or pronunciation often changes (*communicate* > *communication*; *produce* /prəˈdʌkʃn/).

The table below shows some key words from *Opportunities*; check word stress and pronunciation in a good dictionary.
